The Giants will take on the San Diego Padres at 1:00 p.m. and The Marine Mammal Center will be there to cheer the Giants on while raising money to continue the Center's mission of rehabilitating, treating, and releasing ill and orphaned seals, sea lions, otters, dolphins, and other marine mammals. Thanks to the Giants and Chevron, The Marine Mammal Center can educate fans at the ballpark about marine mammals and their ocean environment. The Giants' mascot "Lou Seal," along with the Center's mascot, "Franny the Fur Seal," will be on hand to entertain the crowd and provide photo opportunities. **Fans who make a donation of \$20 or more at the game will receive a limited edition T-shirt and a collectable pin!**

Marine Mammal Day is a great opportunity for fans to learn more about the important work staff and over 800 volunteers do daily at The Marine Mammal Center. Informative displays and marine mammal educators will be stationed throughout the ballpark to answer the public's questions, and fans can become volunteers and members that day. The Center's widely recognized "**Whale Bus**" will be parked outside on the plaza chalked full of handouts and activities.
