## HOW TO GET HERE

### FROM MARIN COUNTY AND POINTS NORTH OF THE GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE:

Take the last Sausalito exit off Highway 101, just before the Golden Gate Bridge. At the exit stop sign, turn right and follow the road under Highway 101 to a second stop sign. Go straight and look immediately for a left turn lane and a sign for "Marin Headlands." Go left and through the tunnel. You will now be on Bunker Road.

Follow directions below from Bunker Road.

### FROM SAN FRANCISCO AND POINTS SOUTH OF THE GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE:

Just after you cross the Golden Gate Bridge, take the second exit off Highway 101 at Alexander Avenue (the exit immediately after the Vista Point exit). Stay to your right; do not turn left at the exit off-ramp and do not go underneath the freeway. Proceed about 500 feet until you see a left turn lane and a sign for "Marin Headlands." (do not go down the hill into Sausalito). Turn left and go through the tunnel. You will now be on Bunker Road.

Follow directions below from Bunker Road.

### FROM BUNKER ROAD:

- Follow Bunker Road for approximately 3 miles.
- Ignore various forks to the left; always bear to the right to make sure you stay on Bunker Road. Rodeo lagoon is your next landmark.
- About halfway alongside the lagoon, the road forks.
- Turn right at that fork. Turn right at your next opportunity; this will lead you up the hill and through our entrance gate.

**PARKING** is available in our parking lot and in designated areas adjacent to the Center. Bikes are welcome, and visitors arriving in Sausalito by ferry can take a taxi to the Center. For information on public transportation to the Center visit <http://www.511.org/>.
