The sea lions at PIER 39 are the most famous wild animals in the San Francisco Bay! Enjoy an educational talk with the Center's educator while observing the sea lions. Learn about their history at PIER 39, their behavior and conservation. Discover how the health of the Bay and ocean influence their presence. Learn how human activities directly affect sea lions.

You will be observing wild sea lions! The number of animals present, and their proximity to the viewing area, varies from season to season. Whether there are 1000 animals or only 10 in view, your group will be engaged and leave with a fresh perspective on these amazing creatures and their ocean home.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

Sea Lions in the City takes place outside with some protection from the weather. Our educator meets your group at the sea lion statue located at the front of PIER 39 near the Blue and Gold Fleet ticket booth. At benches nearby you enjoy an introduction and explore the pelts. We then walk to the end of the pier to observe the sea lions at K dock and talk about behaviors and characteristics. The program concludes upstairs at The Marine Mammal Interpretive Center and Store where we view a complete sea lion skeleton.
