When marine mammals are sick, they're telling us that the ocean is sick, too.

The Marine Mammal Center rescues and cares for these animals, and investigates the threats they face in the wild.

No matter where you live, you can take action to protect marine mammals and ensure a healthy ocean for all!

Keep Your Distance.

Give marine mammals space to rest. Please do not get too close or pour water on them.

Use Your Zoom.

If an animal reacts to your presence, you're too close.

Call the Experts.

Never attempt to rescue a seal or sea lion! Instead, call our **rescue hotline at 415.289.SEAL.**



Reduce Your Plastic Use.

Plastic lasts forever and hurts marine mammals when they eat or get entangled in it.

Take Action!

Carry a reusable water bottle or straw to reduce ocean trash.

Make Ocean-Friendly Seafood Choices.

Overfishing causes fish to disappear. Some fishing methods can also hurt marine mammals.
